2016-09-30 This book is about the amazing story of a US citizen who had to go to Mexico at age four (in the spring of 1958) due to family deportation from the USA and had to tough out extreme poverty; imagine being a partially blind child and having to attend grammar school in Mexico with no special help. He describes how he worked as a child selling vegetables; then, at age thirteen, his father dies, and he had to drop out of school to help the family survive. Together with his two younger brothers, he went to sell chocolate candy and gum in the streets of downtown Mexicali (a border town in the hot desert of Northwest Mexico

(Baja California) until he had a chance to go to work in the USA, where he returned as a teenager in 1968, and went to work in farm labor to help his family in Mexico survive. He had to circumvent US child labor laws. Consequently, he had to face culture shock straight on. The Vietnam War was at its worst for US troops. The reappearance of racial conflicts in the USA was bad; black power, chicano power, and white power were common terms; the hippie movement was booming, and Martin L. Kings and Robert Kennedys assassination had just happened. The drug culture in the USA was thriving; antiwar demonstrations and riots were a common occurrence; Richard Nixon was coming into power; and the Apollo moon project was making headlines. In this narrative, he shares coping techniques for dealing with stress, hopelessness, and adversity. He suggests that, by connecting with people, he achieved personal success and shares his experiences in seeking mentors, joining

events, meeting change agents (community workers, social workers, teachers, and counselors) and joining social movements. Jesse joined student organizations and the independent living movement and learned how to create opportunities that helped him rise from extreme poverty in a Northwest city of Mexico (Mexicali) to being a middle-class citizen in the USA (California) simply by following his mentors leads, by accepting peoples help, and by facing adversity straight on. This is a US citizen who brought back Mexican cultural values and applied them in his work as a vocational rehabilitation counselor in the USA. A very effective counselor, his mission in life is to help others in similar circumstances to succeed, to help family persevere, to say no to drugs or other bad influences, and to encourage others to carry on until the end of the fast train trip. Thats his philosophy of life. Here he shares a few examples of his counseling work, in hopes that these

Estudió la carrera de Derecho en la universidad de Odessa y desde muy joven formó parte de la oposición clandestina que luchaba contra el régimen de los zares. A causa de estas acciones fue detenido varias veces y deportado a Siberia, de donde consiguió huir para reunirse en Londres con el que se consolidaba como jefe de la oposición en el exilio, Lenin. De vuelta en Rusia en 1905 participó en la Revolución como organizador del primer sóviet o consejo revolucionario y, tras el fracaso de esta, fue nuevamente deportado a Siberia, de donde pudo volver a escapar. En cuanto estalló la Revolución de febrero de 1917 que destronó a Nicolás II se trasladó a Rusia para ponerse al servicio del Partido Bolchevique, que lo eligió como presidente del sóviet de Petrogrado. Desempeñó un papel esencial en la conquista del poder de Lenin al ser el principal responsable de la toma del Palacio de Inverno

que instauraba el comunismo en Rusia. Su papel en el gobierno fue crucial hasta la muerte del principal líder soviético, entre otras cosas por su negociación de la paz de Brest-Litovsk con Alemania que suponía la retirada del país de la Primera Guerra Mundial. Posteriormente fue comisario de Guerra (1918-1925), cargo desde el cual organizó el Ejército Rojo, y fue designado sucesor por Lenin antes de morir en 1924, pero se encontró con la ambición de Stalin, que contaba con fuertes apoyos en el aparato del partido y que le impidió acceder al poder apartándolo de la dirección en 1925 y desterrándolo del país en 1929. En el exilio escribió obras como *La revolución permanente* (1930) o *la Historia de la Revolución Rusa* (1932). Finalmente, fue asesinado por un agente soviético, Ramón Mercader, por órdenes de Stalin.
