El hombre cerrado sobre sí Mismo sólo se abrirá a la trascendencia cuando su deseo de alteridad absoluta sea despertado por la irrecusable expresión de Otro, que se insinúa en la dualidad del amor y se suscita plenamente en la fecundidad de este amor.
