Babies have been born and grown up, friends have moved or divorced, but the principals continue to gather in her rustic Cape Cod home to participate in a seder that Piercy takes joy in tweaking each spring to make it more meaningful. In this journey through the ritual, Piercy coaxes us

But I am of the opinion that there is no longer anything that everybody knows how to cook.” It is in that spirit—no question too simple—that Piercy welcomes readers to her kind of seder: a homemade and personal affair, the kind we all
