words. They have been hammering us for the last month, ridiculing our 'worn-out gas-bag, ' an 'old coffeemill for motor, ' telling us we should never leave sight of land, that the wireless plant we carried is a mere bluff, and that all the men engaged to work the ship have 'cold feet.'" I have been rather nettled as I have heard rude remarks in the hangar...
