The Verbal Truth of Christianity effects to bring you to the crux of the central message of the Jesus mission, a universal one of reality's truer nature, the defining of God and cosmos in believable and constructive terms; an understanding of the eternal realm and our relation to it. A simple message overlooked by scholars, yet of such complexity it takes lifetimes to realize; to see and understand how by ignorance and fear we frame our living narratives in birth and death -- necessitating a false mortality. In Chapter 1 this book offers a greater explanation of what "life" is and sets a foundation for a more developed, elevated, meaningful, concept of "God". Chapter 2 opens with a short exploration of the time and place setting of the story of Jesus, making effort for determining who he was, what he said, why he said it, and further to sift out what he said that the Christian Church embraced, and what he said that the Church rejected. And more importantly, we will begin to see what the Church teaches that Jesus never said or taught. In Chapter 3 we will briefly look at credible gospels of Jesus that the Church rejected then and still rejects now, primarily the "Gnostic" Gospel of Thomas lost to the ages until uncovered by chance in 1945. Chapter 4 reconciles the canonical (New Testament) gospels of the Christian Church with legitimate rejected gospels that the Church deemed heretical (wrong teachings). From this, and with our more elevated understanding of life and who God is, a clear Jesus message emerges of which logic and understanding replaces the childlike message of "faith". In Chapter 5 we look at the sameness between the true Jesus message and other religions, philosophies and sciences. Chapter 6 puts it all together into a single unified message answering our purpose for being here in this world now and ahead.

The Internal Foe Jeremy F. Worthen 2008-12-18 The relationship between Christianity and other religions is a vital issue in the world today. This book provides a fresh perspective by exploring how Christian theology has been shaped over two millennia by interaction with its original religious "other", continuing Judaism. It begins by describing the origins of the "classic framework" in Christianity that correlates claims about the gospel with judgments about Judaism as resistance to the new thing God has done in Jesus Christ. This framework binds Christianity to the task of interpreting Jewish presence, which then renders engaging with Judaism as well as rehearsing judgments about it integral to Christian theology's development. The central chapters of the book demonstrate this in relation to three pivotal periods of Western history: 1050-1300 CE, early modernity and the first half of the twentieth century. Christ Sutras Bart Marshall 2023-11-11 There was a game, you may remember, that schoolteachers had us play as kids where a person at one corner of the classroom whispers a sentence to the next person, who whispers it to the next person and so on until it is whispered to the last person, who says out loud what he thought he heard in his ear. The teacher then reads the original sentence, which of course bears little resemblance to what the last person thought was said. The words of Jesus have no doubt suffered a similar fate, passing through decades, even centuries, of ears and minds before being written down. Yet miraculously, the essence of his teachings has survived, and contained within the sayings attributed to Jesus Christ are some of the most profound and moving pointers to Truth ever voiced. After his death, the words and teachings of Jesus lived on in a diverse and vibrant oral tradition. Sects formed around different aspects or interpretations of the teachings, and over the next few hundred years, thousands of manuscripts appeared claiming to contain the words and teachings of Jesus, each emphasizing and embellishing those aspects most important to the writer and the sect to which he belonged. There were arguments between sects, of course, as to which among them should be considered the true church, and over time several powerful contenders emerged. Not surprisingly, the group backed by the Roman emperor eventually came out on top. In 325 AD they convened a council at Nicaea and declared themselves the one and only Christian Church. They issued a creed specifying official Church beliefs, and from the thousands of Christian writings in circulation, chose twenty-seven to become the approved canon, the New Testament. The rest became apocrypha, from the Greek, meaning, "those left out." Most of these writings were declared heretical by the new Church and many were ordered destroyed. Sects that taught an aspect of Christianity in conflict with official Church doctrine were forced underground. Copies of some apocrypha texts have survived, mostly in fragments, but they are still largely ignored by the modern Church. Interest in apocrypha texts among individuals, however, both Christian and non-Christian, has increased dramatically in recent decades, due mainly to the discovery of thirteen leather-bound papyrus codices found buried in a cave near Nag Hammadi, Egypt in 1945. The wife of the farmer who discovered them burned one of the codices as fuel for cooking, but twelve survive, containing over fifty ancient Christian texts. Now popularly known as the Gnostic Gospels, these books, The Gospel of Thomas chief among them, have become the focal point for a new examination of the essential teachings of Christ. In them are sayings that exhort us as individuals to experience directly the Truth of God for ourselves, and thus become a Christ, a Son of God. Interestingly, once we see this teaching expressed more clearly in some of the apocrypha, it is easier to see that it can be found throughout the New Testament as well. Christian mystics like Saint John of the Cross and Meister Eckhart experienced first hand the truth of this teaching, and wrote about the wonder of discovering that, as Eckhart puts it, "The eye with which I see God is the same eye with which God sees me." Or as Jesus says, "He who knows himself, at the same time knows the Totality of the All." This is the teaching that drew me to the project that has become Christ Sutras. I hope you enjoy it.
